Mission Community Grants 2005-2006

The ECD Committee in conjunction with the Children First initiative (from the Ministry of Children and Family Development) and Success By 6 (a United Way and B.C. government early learning initiative) has distributed \$23,565 in funds to groups in the community. A tender for grants was advertised in local newspapers in December and final decisions were made in January.

Projects had to target children zero to 6 and their families and enhance their development, health and well-being.

Applicants submitted many wonderful proposals. Chosen projects included:

- Story Telling Kits from Fraser Valley Regional Library to develop new storytelling kits and refurbish and expand older kits. These kits are available for borrowing at the Mission library, 33247 2nd Ave., 604-826-6610.
